Dear Praying Friends,

Thank you so much for praying about the supplies that John and Fernanda brought back in June but were held in customs. John decided to make a trip into Belém in one last attempt to talk with the officials and at least ask for the trunks holding the supplies if he wasn't able to recover the supplies. The man who was working that day was most helpful and a little confused about why the supplies were held in the first place. After paying a storage fee, the supplies were released and are already being put to good use!

The initial hearing about the invasion of the land where the Scriptures signs were, was held on August 18th. John and Fernanda are still waiting for a decision by the judge. Please continue to pray!

Someone has graciously offered to buy a trailer and the hook-up needed for John and Fernanda's car. This will allow them to carry their three children after the baby comes as well as the supplies in the trailer for the work in the villages. Brazilian law requires a different license for this and so Fernanda is in the process of upgrading her license to be able to drive the car and trailer. Brazilian law also states that she can only test for this up through her sixth month of pregnancy. This deadline is quickly approaching so she has a test set up for September 10th. Please pray!

At the beginning of 2014, Robynn and Hannah were invited to hold a children's Bible class in the village of Jutaizinho. Each Thursday we would go at 8:00 a.m. sing, teach a verse and a Bible lesson, give a coloring activity to the children and head down the road to Jutai. In June of last year that door closed as our hostess was unable to continue. It was at that time that the Lord opened the door for children's class and eventually a women's Bible study in Helderlândia. A couple of weeks ago the Lord reopened the door to Jutaizinho. We were thrilled, yet wondering how to work

Jutaizinho into our already filled Thursday schedule. When we got to Helderlândia that week we found that they needed to change their schedule from Thursday to Friday☺
The Lord's timing is perfect!
